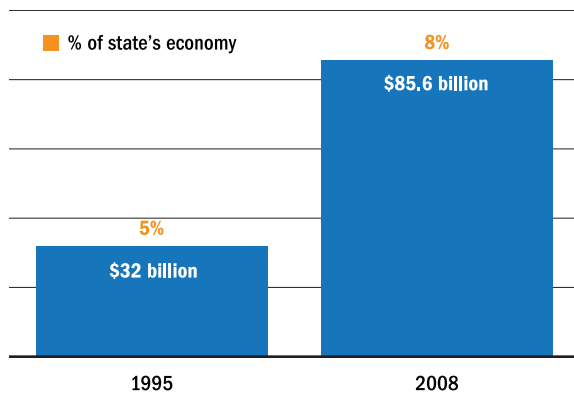
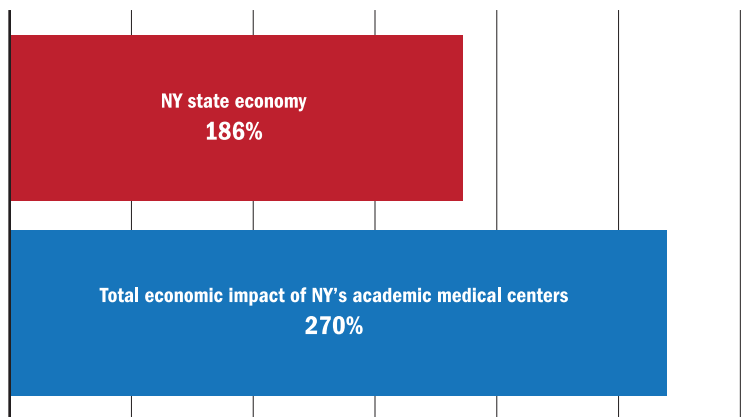


It's no surprise that medical education is a big industry in New York. What might surprise is just how big an industry it is, especially when compared with the rest of the country. The findings in this edition of *Pulse Extra*, the first in a series of two, are from "The Impact of Medical Education in the State of New York," published this year by the Associated Medical Schools of New York. The study's conclusions are based on data from 2008 and, unless otherwise noted, cover New York's 15 medical schools and 82 affiliated teaching hospitals.

NYS' MEDICAL EDUCATION MARKETSHARE

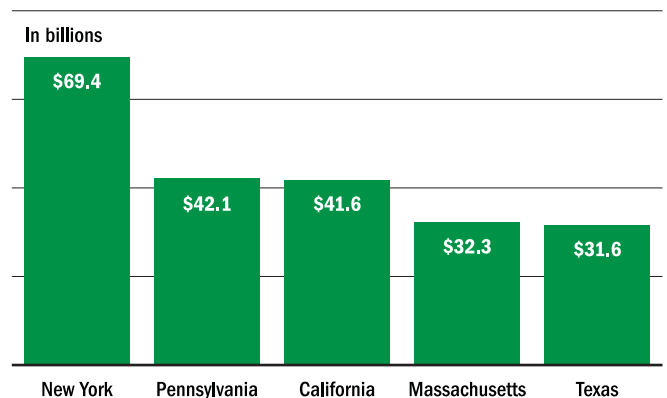
NEW YORK accounts for about **6.3%** of the U.S. population and **10%** of its medical schools.

MEDICAL SCHOOLS IN NY train approximately **11%** of the nation's medical students and **15%** of its residents.

ONE WEAKNESS: Medical schools in NY received more than **\$1 billion** in National Institutes of Health research grants in 2008, or about **5%** of all NIH grant dollars awarded to medical schools that year.

ACADEMIC MEDICAL CENTERS CONTRIBUTED more than **\$500 billion** to the U.S. economy in 2008, or about **3.6%** of the total U.S. economy. NY represents nearly **14%** of the total U.S. impact of academic medical centers.
